



KINDERGARTEN CLASSROOM CURRICULUM

FIVE-YEAR OLD KINDERGARTEN (K5)

Bible, *Positive Action for Christ – Learning About God*

Students are taught Sunday-School style lessons, memorize verses and songs.

Skills Development, *A Beka Books*

Students are taught habits, colors, cutting skills, sound identification, visual perceptions, same concepts, writing readiness, telephone skills, manners, motor coordination activities, listening/thinking activities, and health and safety visuals

Phonics, *A Beka Books*

Students are taught to recognize all upper and lower-case letters in the alphabet, concepts of five vowels, constant-vowel blends, one and two-vowel words, sight words, sentences, capitals, and periods, adding final consonants to blends to make one and two-vowel words, short, long, and silent vowel sounds, 's possessives

Writing, *A Beka Books*

Students are taught to write all upper and lower-case letters, blends, and words learned in phonics. Capital letters, phrases and sentences are also practices.

Reading, *A Beka Books*

Students are reading in class and have daily reading homework assignments by 2nd semester. Students are taught to build speed, accuracy, and comprehension during daily classroom reading groups.

Activity Time, *A Beka Books*

Includes Music; Art; Community Helpers; America: Our Great Country; Children of the World: Mexico, Peru, England, The Netherlands, Italy, Israel, Kenya, China, Japan, and Australia; Science, God's Plan for Me, Weather, Seasons, Seeds, Animals, and the Seashore.

Numbers, *A Beka Books*

Students are taught to count from 1-100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's, recognize and value money, understand the concepts of greater than, longer, taller, shorter, before, between, and after numbers, write numbers 1-100, memorize combinations one through ten families, understand smallest to largest concepts, and subtraction.

Spanish, *Bob Jones University Press*

Students are taught to grasp the basics of Spanish. Students learn the colors, numbers, days of the week, and body parts. Poetry and songs are included.

Music

Students receive daily instruction in music theory using visual aids, boom whackers, and melody bells.
